After the Samajwadi Party President, Akhilesh Yadav, got to know about the little one, he sent a car to Maharajganj to bring Shyamal to Etawah. The Samajwadi Party patriarch, Mulayam Singh Yadav, passed away on October 10.

### Delhi CM Arvind Kejriwal announces grand Chhath celebrations at 1100 sites

**New Delhi** Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal announced that the government would prepare for a grand Chhath celebration across 1100 sites in Delhi. After a wait of two long years, Delhi is set to witness a state-wide festive fervour.

"Before we came to power, Chhath was a formality for the government. In 2014, there were barely 69 sites where Chhath was celebrated here in Delhi. The government back then spent a mere 2.5 crores on it. But now, we will celebrate Chhath on a very large scale across 1,100 sites in Delhi," Arvind Kejriwal said.

"Among our core responsibilities, we have prioritised the safety and security of every citizen. To make this possible, we will seek the help of the Delhi Police and install CCTVs all around our Chhath Ghats," Delhi CM highlighted.

The Delhi government plans to make arrangements for drinking water, sanitation, toilets, ambulances, first-aid, tents, furniture, sound systems, lighting, and LED screens for the festival.

# Kerala: After 'human sacrifice' case, woman held for 'BLACK MAGIC' ritual using children

**Pathanamthitta:** A woman from Pathanamthitta, a district in Kerala, has been arrested for allegedly practising occult rituals using children. This came days after the horrific case of 'human sacrifices in the same district. The woman identified as Shobhana alias Vasanti was allegedly performing occult rituals in which children were forced to take part and a video of the same had gone viral on the internet. Post this, locals protested against her. The accused woman along with her friend identified as Unnikrishnan were taken into custody by police. Meanwhile, a special investigation team (SIT) has been formed by the Kerala Police to conduct a detailed probe into the suspected 'human sacrifice' of two women in the Pathanamthitta district. The team will be headed by S Sasidharan, Deputy Commissioner (Law and Order), Kochi City and Perumbavoor ACP Anooj Paliwal as the chief investigating officer. The three accused, the husband-wife couple Bhagaval Singh and



Laila and Muhammed Shafi were arrested on Tuesday. Remains of the two deceased women identified as Padma and Roslin were exhumed on October 11 from pits near the residence of Singh and Laila at Elanthoor in Pathanamthitta district.



According to a police remand report filed before a court that the shocking "human sacrifices" were suspected to have been committed as part of a ritual to obtain financial benefits. The accused allegedly lured the victims with the promise of money

and allegedly chopped up the bodies of the victims before burying them, police said. On September 26, Shafi approached the 52-year-old Padma, who used to sell lottery tickets at Kochi and lured her by offering Rs 15,000 for sex work, the police remand report read. Then she agreed and went with Shafi to the home of Bhagaval Singh and Laila in the Pathanamthitta district. There, the accused strangled her with a plastic cord around her neck to make her unconscious. After that, Shafi mutilated Padma's private parts using a knife and slit her throat. After that, they chopped her into 56 pieces and put the mutilated body parts into buckets and buried them in a pit," the report detailed. Police said that it is investigating the possibility of cannibalism that the accused possibly ate the flesh of the victims. Kochi Police Commissioner CH Nagaraju addressing a press conference told reporters that Shafi, the main accused, was a pervert and has a criminal past.

## Lumpy skin disease kills 2,070 cattle in Karnataka, vaccination drive on-going

Lumpy skin disease has affected about 45,645 cattle in Karnataka as per the state government. CM Bommai has ordered officials to intensify the vaccination drive against the disease,



**Bengaluru:** As many as 2,070 cattle have died due to the Lumpy Skin Disease (LSD) in Karnataka, while about 19,000 are affected, the state government said on Friday. Karnataka Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai has ordered releasing Rs 13 crore for the treatment and vaccination of cattle suffering from this viral disease and also to provide relief to those who lost their cattle due to it. He instructed officials to intensify the vaccination drive, especially in Haveri

and Kolar districts where the prevalence is high, a government statement said. "This disease has been noticed in 4,380 villages of 160 taluks in 28 districts. Of the total 45,645 cattle afflicted by this disease, 26,135 have recovered and 2,070 have died," the statement said. It added that Rs 2 crore had already been released as compensation for those who lost cattle. "An additional Rs five crore will be released towards the treatment of diseased cattle and Rs eight crore for

vaccinating them," the statement said. The Chief Minister was quoted as saying that as many as 6.57 lakh cattle have been vaccinated. As per guidelines of the Government of India, even healthy cattle within a five km range where this disease has been noticed must be vaccinated. "The vaccination must be done on priority in the chronically affected districts," the Chief Minister said and directed officials to immediately obtain 15 lakh doses of vaccine from companies approved by the Government of India.

The Chief Minister noted that lumpy disease does not spread to people by drinking milk from ailing cows, and awareness in this regard must be created on a big scale. Steps must be taken to check this disease in badly-hit districts such as Haveri and Kolar; preventive steps should be taken so that it does not spread to other districts. The vaccination drive must be intensified, he said. LSD is a contagious viral disease that affects cattle and causes fever, and nodules on the skin and can also lead to death. The disease gets spread by mosquitoes, flies, lice, and wasps by direct contact among the cattle, and through contaminated food and water.
