Delhi CM Arvind Kejriwal announces grand Chhath celebrations at 1100 sites

New Delhi Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal announced that the government would prepare for a grand Chhath celebration across 1100 sites in Delhi.

"Before we came to power, Chhath was a formality for the government. In 2014, there were barely 69 sites where Chhath was celebrated here in Delhi.

"Among our core responsibilities, we have prioritised the safety and security of every citizen. To make this possible, we will seek the help of the Delhi Police and install CCTVs all around our Chhath Ghats," Delhi CM highlighted.

The Delhi government plans to make arrangements for drinking water, sanitation, toilets, ambulances, first-aid, tents, furniture, sound systems, lighting, and LED screens for the festival.
